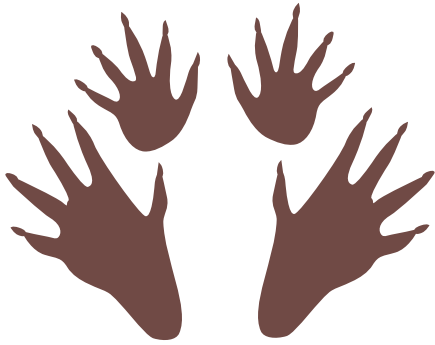




Use the guidelines to cut out each animal track card. Punch a hole in the right corner and bind with a ring to carry on your camping adventures.



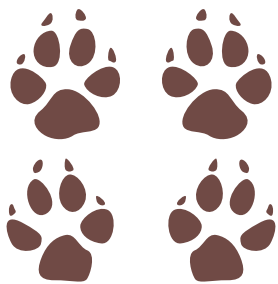
RACCOON

- Front paws measure 3" in length & back paws measure 3-4".
- **Fun fact: Their black masks help them see clearly by reducing glare.**



PORCUPINE

- Paws measure 1-2" in length.
- **Fun fact: A porcupine has approximately 30,000 quills on its body.**



COYOTE

- Front paws measure 2-3" in length & back paws measure 1¾-3".
- **Fun fact: Coyotes have 42 teeth.**



TURKEY

- Tracks measure: 3¾-5" long by 4-5 ½" wide.
- **Fun fact: An adult gobbler weighs 16 to 22 pounds on average.**

SQUIRREL

- Front paws measure $1 \frac{1}{16}$ " in length & back paws measure $1 \frac{3}{4}$ ".
- **Fun fact:** Squirrels run erratically to confuse predators.



RABBIT

- Front paws measure $\frac{7}{8}$ -1" & back paws measure $2 \frac{3}{4}$ ".
- **Fun fact:** More than half of the world's rabbits live in North America.



DEER

- Tracks measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ -4" in length.
- **Fun fact:** Male deer grow a new set of antlers every year.



SKUNK

- Paws measure $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " in length.
- **Fun fact:** Skunks do a warning dance before they spray.
